Eligibility

1. All applicants must be a member in good standing in their school music program.
2. Applicants must be at least 12 years old by September 30.

Audition Information

1. Auditions will be held at Cross of Life Lutheran Church, 1000 Hembree Road, Roswell, on Sunday, September 10.
2. Once the application and fee are submitted-the audition repertoire will be mailed out mid June.
3. Notification of audition time will be mailed the week of Sept. 4.

Tuition Fee

A tuition fee of \$320 is assessed for the year for the Ludwig Symphony Orchestra. The fee is payable in two installments of \$160. The first payment is due no later than the first rehearsal on Sunday, September 17. The second installment is due no later than January 14.

Rehearsal and Concert Information:

Rehearsals are held on Sundays from 3:30 to 6:00 p.m. at Cross of Life Church.

Concert dates are Sunday, November 12 at 4p.m. Gwinnett Center, and Saturday February 3, and May 5, at 8p.m. at the Roswell Cultural Arts Center.

Membership Responsibilities

1. One of a student's top priorities must be LSO rehearsals, Attendance at all rehearsals and concerts is mandatory.
2. A maximum of **five** excused absences is allowed for the entire season provided written notice is received by the LSO office **prior** to the absence.
3. Unexcused absences are unacceptable and may result in dismissal from the orchestra.
